### **1.1. THE STREETS OF THE BARBARY COAST**

Downtown Street named for Swiss-German land baron who established a prominent fort in Sacramento and owned the land grant where gold was discovered in January 1848

### **1.2. CITY LIGHTS**

Photograph the cover of *The Grapes of Wrath* and then enter the Poetry Room and photograph *San Francisco Poems* by Lawrence Ferlinghetti

### **1.3. LOST BARBARY COAST**

Plaque commemorating site of Ralston's Bank of California

### **1.4. LOST DOWNTOWN**

Find the plaque commemorating the Original Location of A.P. Gianinni's Bank of Italy

### **1.5. UPTOWN**

Last Remaining Nob Hill Mansion of a Silver Bonanza King

### **1.6. OBSCURE UPTOWN**

Locate Nob Hill Street named for *noir* author of "The Maltese Falcon"

### **1.7. HISTORIC EATS**

The Buich Family made this Gold Rush dish comprised of oysters and eggs famous *here*

### **1.8. HISTORIC IMBIBING**

Locate plaque commemorating the former site of the Barbary Coast's infamous Billy Goat Saloon

### **1.9. BARBARY COAST OBSCURA**

Barbary Coast saloon (c.1849), originally the schooner *Arkansas*, infamous for "Shanghaiing" customers

### **1.10. RALSTON'S SAN FRANCISCO GEM**

This Mural by Maxfield Parrish has adorned this spot since 1909

### **1.11. DOWNTOWN GATEKEEPERS**

Locate indoor statue of the self-proclaimed Emperor of the U.S and Protector of Mexico

### **1.12. LOST BARBARY COAST**

Historical marker for the former shipwreck hotel, the Niantic

### **1.13. LOST DOWNTOWN II**

Locate downtown historical marker for the original site of the college that later became USF

### **1.14. OBSCURE SAN FRANCISCO**

Marker for the former site of William Richardson's adobe, proclaiming "The Birthplace of a Great City"

### **1.15. BARBARY COAST RIDDLES**

This structure survived the earthquake by proclaiming: "Son, Observe the Time, and Fly From Evil"

## **2.0 The Hounds Midterm**

### **2.1. THE STREETS OF THE BARBARY COAST**

Downtown Street named for American Commander of the Pacific Squadron (not Commodore Sloat) during the Mexican-American War

### **2.2 CITY LIGHTS**

Locate and photograph one book by the San Francisco Examiner reporter who disappeared in Mexico in 1913. Locate and photograph the cover of Jack Kerouac, *On the Road*.

### **2.3. LOST BARBARY COAST**

This Modern Street Was Once the Gold Rush-era “Long Wharf”

### **2.4. LOST DOWNTOWN**

Locate the former Barbary Coast Hippodrome Bar and Dance Hall

### **2.5. UPTOWN**

Nob Hill Hotel (site of his former mansion) named for Big Four frontman and California governor

### **2.6 OBSCURE UPTOWN**

Nob Hill Street Named for Author of the “*Maltese Falcon*”

### **2.7. HISTORIC EATS**

The Buich Family made this Gold Rush dish comprised of oysters and eggs famous *here*

### **2.8. HISTORIC IMBIBING**

Current home of the Cocktail named for “founder of the Bank of California”

### **2.9. BARBARY COAST OBSCURA**

The “all-seeing eye” will help you locate a marker for the Vigilance Committee Headquarters, or “fort”

### **2.10. RALSTON’S SAN FRANCISCO GEM**

This Mural by Maxfield Parrish has adorned this spot since 1909

### **2.11. DOWNTOWN GATEKEEPERS**

Current Display Place of Sam Spade’s prized bird [you must photograph the item]

### **2.12. LOST BARBARY COAST**

Historical marker for the former shipwreck hotel, the Niantic

### **2.13. LOST DOWNTOWN II**

Downtown Building Bearing the Family Name of Former USF graduate, Mayor, and Notoriously Anti-Asian Senator

### **2.14. OBSCURE SAN FRANCISCO**

Sidewalk Plaque Remembering the Barbary Coast’s “Little Chile”

### **2.15. BARBARY COAST RIDDLES**

Locate Historical Marker Observing: "If, as they say, God spanked the town, for being over frisky, why did he burn the churches down, and save \_\_\_\_\_'s whiskey?"

#### **3.1. THE STREETS OF THE BARBARY COAST**

Downtown Street named for American pathfinder who captained the California Battalion and later became the state's first US Senator

#### **3.2. CITY LIGHTS**

Photograph cover of *The Octopus* and then enter the Poetry Room and photograph *The Selected Poetry of Robinson Jeffers*.

#### **3.3. LOST BARBARY COAST**

Locate the Site of the First U.S. Branch Mint in San Francisco

#### **3.4. LOST DOWNTOWN**

Former headquarters and building named for famed publisher of *San Francisco Examiner*

#### **3.5. UPTOWN**

Nob Hill Hotel named for the Big Four's leader and "Great Persuader"

#### **3.6. OBSCURE UPTOWN**

Locate the Relief Depicting Bret Harte's "Luck of the Roaring Camp"

#### **3.7. HISTORIC EATS**

The current home of Victor Hirtzler's eponymous culinary creation

#### **3.8. HISTORIC IMBIBING**

Find the Current home of the Cocktail alleged to be the original martini

#### **3.9. BARBARY COAST OBSCURA**

The "all-seeing eye" will help you locate a marker for the Vigilance Committee Headquarters, or "fort"

#### **3.10. RALSTON'S SAN FRANCISCO GEM**

Exact Location (including room number) of President Harding's Death in 1923

Downtown Marker commemorating prominent African-American of pre-Gold Rush days

This former site of Lucky Baldwin's Hotel has Housed Both the Southern Pacific Railroad and the Detective Agency that Employed Dashiell Hammett

#### **3.14. OBSCURE SAN FRANCISCO**

The former site of William Richardson's adobe, proclaiming "The Birthplace of a Great City"

#### **3.15. BARBARY COAST RIDDLES**

Locate "Uncle Billy Cump's" Barbary Coast Office

Historical marker for Montgomery's 1846 *landing* site

### **4.2 CITY LIGHTS**

Photograph cover of *The Octopus* and then enter the Poetry Room and photograph the cover of Allen Ginsburg's *Howl*

### **4.3. LOST BARBARY COAST**

Locate an original San Francisco Bay shoreline marker

### **4.4. LOST DOWNTOWN**

Downtown alley named for author of "The Celebrated Jumping Frog of Calaveras County"

### **4.5. UPTOWN**

Nob Hill Hotel named for the Big Four's eccentric "numbers guy"

### **4.6. OBSCURE UPTOWN**

Park Named for California's First Poet Laureate

### **4.7. HISTORIC EATS**

The current home of Victor Hirtzler's eponymous culinary creation

### **4.8. HISTORIC IMBIBING**

Find the Current home of the Cocktail alleged to be the original martini

### **4.9. BARBARY COAST OBSCURA**

Barbary Coast saloon (c.1849), originally the schooner *Arkansas*, infamous for "Shanghaiing" customers

### **4.10. RALSTON'S SAN FRANCISCO GEM**

Locate portraits of William Ralston and William Sharon on the same wall

### **4.11. DOWNTOWN GATEKEEPERS**

Locate the Exact Location (including Room Number) of the 1921 Fatty Arbuckle Incident

### **4.12. LOST BARBARY COAST**

Historical marker for San Francisco's first newspaper (c. 1847), Sam Brannan's *California Star*

### **4.13. LOST DOWNTOWN II**

Locate downtown historical marker for the original site of the college that later became USF

### **4.14. OBSCURE SAN FRANCISCO**

Sidewalk marker for notorious political Boss Abe Ruef's former headquarters

### **4.15. BARBARY COAST RIDDLES**

You'll "Juana" locate this plaque for North Beach settler and Mexican land grantee

## **5.0. Little Pete's Tong**

### **5.1. THE STREETS OF THE BARBARY COAST**

Locate Nob Hill Street named for *noir* author of "The Maltese Falcon"

### **5.2. CITY LIGHTS**

Photograph the cover of *In Dubious Battle* and then enter Poetry Room and photograph Diane di Prima's *Memoirs of a Beatnik*

### **5.3. LOST BARBARY COAST**

This Institute houses the oldest library on the West Coast and one of the oldest chess clubs in America

### **5.4. LOST DOWNTOWN**

A "Lotta" Survivors of 1906 gathered here on every earthquake anniversary

### **5.5. UPTOWN**

This plaque demarcates the site of the former mansion of Big Four member & construction boss

### **5.6. OBSCURE UPTOWN**

Locate the Nob Hill Relief Depicting Bret Harte's "Luck of the Roaring Camp"

### **5.7. HISTORIC EATS**

The Buich Family made this Gold Rush dish comprised of oysters and eggs famous *here*

### **5.8. HISTORIC IMBIBING**

This Vesuvio's Cocktail spent a lot of time "*On the Road*"

### **5.9. BARBARY COAST OBSCURA**

Locate Little Pete's Assassination site

### **5.10. RALSTON'S SAN FRANCISCO GEM**

Exact Location (including room number) of President Harding's Death in 1923

### **5.11. DOWNTOWN GATEKEEPERS**

Locate the Exact Location (including Room Number) of the 1921 Fatty Arbuckle Incident

### **5.12. LOST BARBARY COAST**

Alley named for the San Francisco *Examiner's* famous reporter who went missing in 1913

### **5.13. LOST DOWNTOWN II**

This former site of Lucky Baldwin's Hotel has Housed Both the Southern Pacific Railroad and the Detective Agency that Employed Dashiell Hammett

### **5.14. OBSCURE SAN FRANCISCO**

This Exclusive Nob Hill Owl warns "Weaving Spiders Come Not Here"

### **5.15. BARBARY COAST RIDDLES**

Barbary Coast alley named for 1850s San Francisco banker and later Civil War General. You might need to use your "Old Brains" for the answer
